Please let me thank you for your letter of 28.01.2005, answering my request for access to OLAF report I/03318 - 23.11.04, case CMS OF/2004/0257.

You have sent me the document; however some parts of this document have been excluded from access. I would like to request you to review this position and confirm my initial request to have access to the whole document.

Please let me inform you that, in accordance with Regulation 1049/2001, I will refrain from reproduction or dissemination for commercial purposes. Also I do not see how the privacy and integrity of the individuals concerned is at stake when I would be granted access to the document.

If however, you still feel that you can not supply those parts of the document that have been excluded previously, I would like to propose that I can look at the document without being able to take a copy with me, similar to the arrangement that already exists for members of the EP Committee of Budgetary control, when they want to read those investigative documents that can not be released.
